January 27<sup>th</sup> is **International Holocaust Remembrance Day**. The Jewish Community Havura and Beth El Synagogue will remember the survivors and victims of the holocaust with a special observance incorporated into the Friday evening Shabbat service.

Reflecting Jewish practice, men will be expected to cover their heads with a kippa or yarmulke, available in the synagogue lobby. Women may choose to do so as well.
